Building Strong Communities



- \$14 Million in mortgage financing for 63 families
- \$2.7 Million invested in local economy
- 114 full and part time positions created or retained

- 2,045 Citizens engaged in Energy Efficiency & Conservation through Appalachia CARES AmeriCorps member service
- 6,020 Youth provided with environmental & experiential education through AmeriCorps member service
